Dear CCA Presidents and Directors,

Re: CCA JOA Legal Consideration - Exploratory Session March 25

I am writing to provide you with an update on the process for reviewing and considering the outstanding legal issues in the proposed Joint Operating Agreement (JOA) as <u>directed by the Board</u>. We will be proceeding with the Exploratory Session on Saturday, March 25 as planned. All CCAs are welcome to attend the meeting and may, at their option, have their legal counsel attend. The purpose of the session is for Park Board staff and legal counsel to ensure we fully understand all legal concerns the CCAs have with respect to the draft JOA.

Through this Exploratory Session and your written submissions, we hope to understand all barriers that may stop the CCAs from legally being able to sign the JOA. Our goal is to capture a summary of all legal issues from the Exploratory Session. We will distribute a copy to all CCA Presidents and Directors after the meeting for full transparency.
