


STREETSCAPE ALONG QUEBEC STREET FACING EAST



STREETSCAPE ANALYSIS:

As per the CD-1 Bylaws and Guidelines for 3A, & 3B, Bullding 2 occupies the middle ground of an ascending height structure as one heads northward from 1st, Avenue to Steince World. While his lower compronent is similar in height to the bullding to the south, both podium heights ascend as prescribed, with set back penthouse levels on each to reduce street scale presence as well as forecasting light to the public realm along Quebec Street, the internal courtyard area and the park to the west.


STREETS CAPE NOTES:


- Indier Julaing elements are spaced rielphiely equally clong Quebes. Street to allow for views past and through. Podiums step up in height to the north as they do on the east side of Quebes. Street.


 All 2 tracey partitiouse levels are to be set back somewhat from the mojority of facades and employ a material change.



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- The Building 2 tower location, proportional ordentation, and podlum height, have been followed as illustrated in the Rezoning Application, 3. & 38 Guidelines, and as required by the CD-1 bylaw.
- As an evolving urban boulevard, Quebec Street is an important vehicular ariented throughtare to and from the downlown permisular. A kile to and from the downlown permisular. A kile route system, future surface roil. 4 fance of vehicular traffic, and pedestian sidewalks strare this route and are physically separated for safety reasons. A pedestian sidewalk and expanded sets acts (divide the vehicles from the homes and includated enteriors with rotated terraces divide public and private realms.

The original ODP prescribed a "streetwall" configuration along Quebec, with podiums and towers forming a strong presence and sense of contamment on both east and west sides of the street. Building 2 follows this notion.

With the proposed location of the tower component, space between the taller tower elements of Bulding I and 5 have been kept at approximately 2001, leaving a considerable distance for privacy and view considerations. Views through to the west for neighbours to the east have been optimized, and daylight penetration to the street has been as well.
