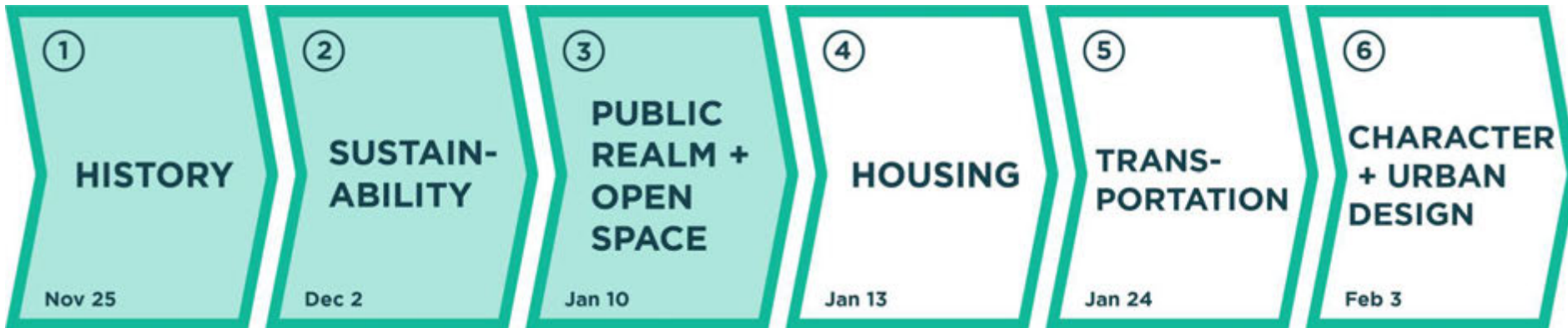

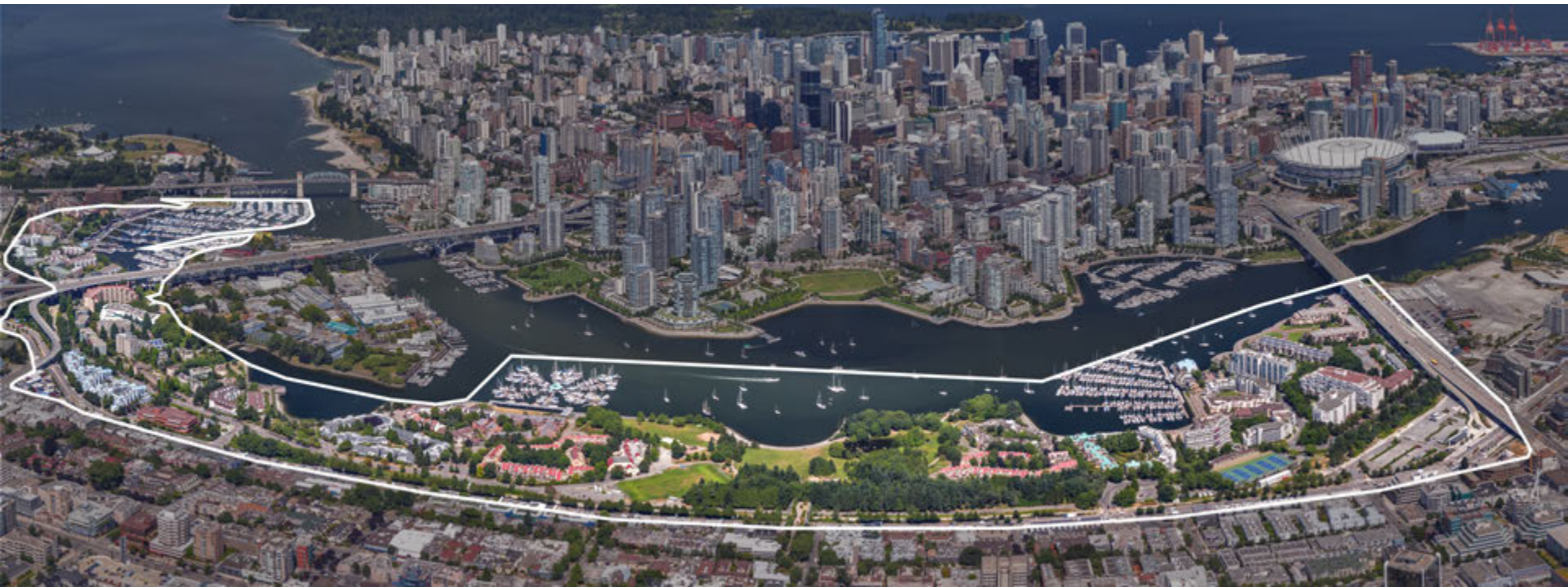

Planning Process Timeline

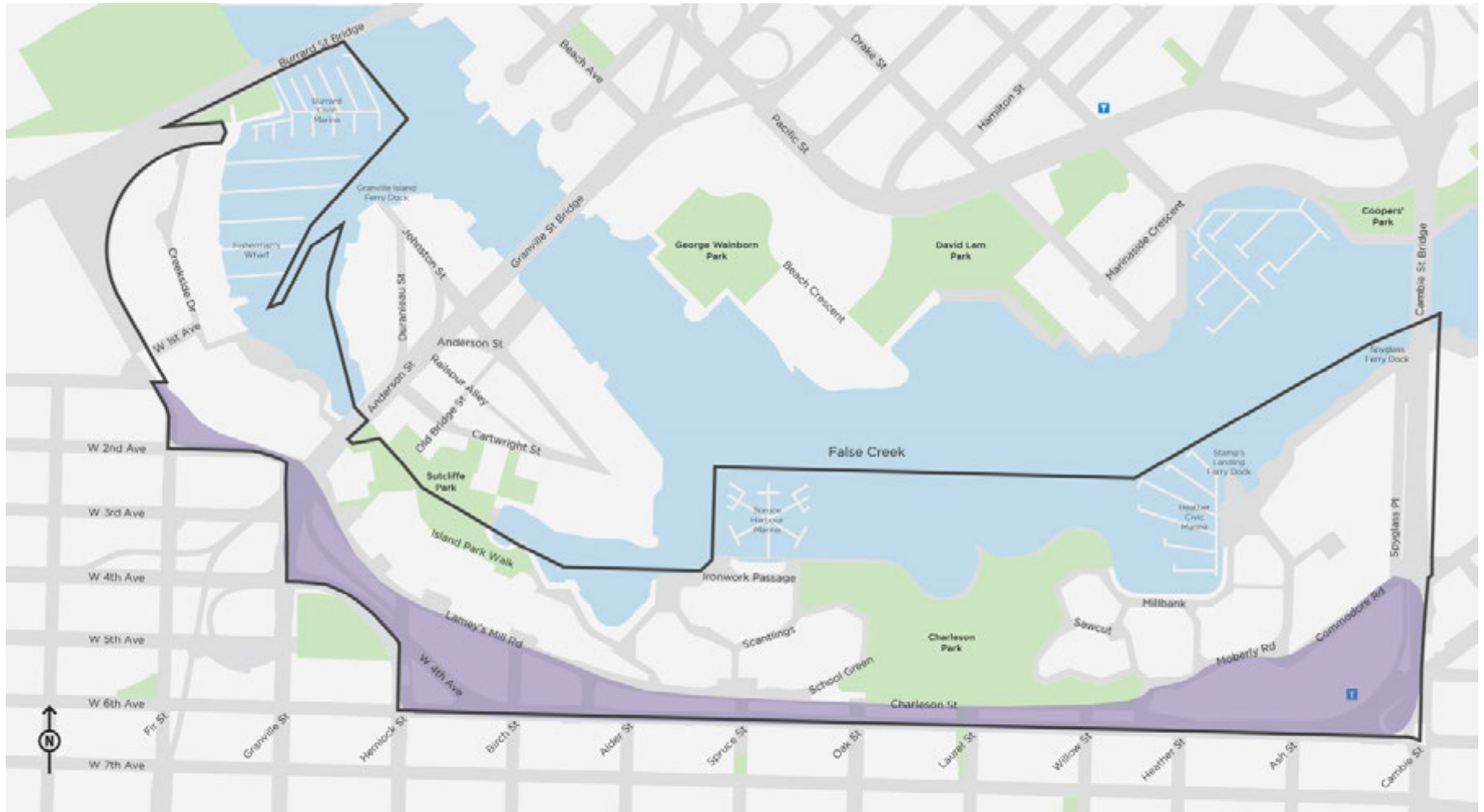

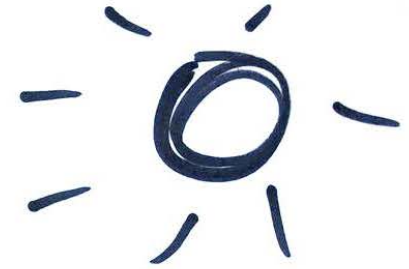
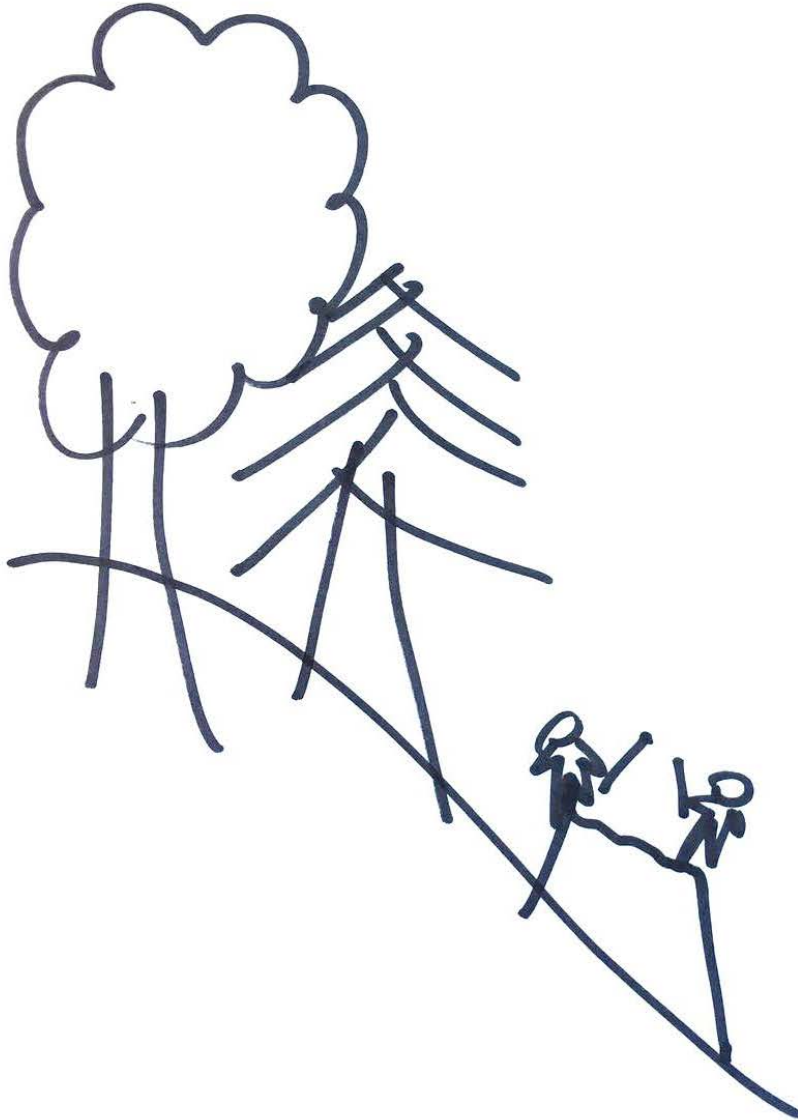

GROUND RULES
