Why are we Creating a John Hendry Park Master Plan?

A park master plan will set directions and identify priorities for John Hendry Park over the next 10-15 years. It is an opportunity to understand the values of John Hendry park users today and explore innovations that could create a healthy, thriving environment and recreation destination for the future.

The master plan is the next step in improvements to John Hendry Park. In 2009, the Trout Lake Rink was replaced in preparation for the 2010 Winter Games. The community centre was replaced two years later with the new LEED gold Trout Lake Community Centre, opening to the public in 2012.

The objective of the planning process is to ensure the park continues to be a healthy and well-loved community space for years to come.

The master plan will support the Greenest City 2020 Action Plan goals to enhance biodiversity, improve ecological health, reduce combined sewer overflows, and increase access to nature and the Park Board Strategy Framework Vision to connect people to green space, active living and community.
