1. Training and Employment Opportunities

Inner-city residents interested in working on construction at Olympic Village can access this training and the 100 jobs by:

2. Business Opportunities

To become a supplier to the construction and retrofit of Olympic Village to the value of \$15 million in goods and services and to access other business supports offered by BOB:

- Register with BOB as an inner-city supplier or a business that supports inner-city businesses
- Join 200+ businesses in the BOB construction supplier directory
- Attend the workshops and open houses organized by BOB to bring together buyers and suppliers

3. The Money

BOB will use the \$750,000 contribution from Millennium Southeast False Creek Properties Ltd to pay for 4 job readiness courses, 5 VRCA CORE training courses and 1 VRCA CEP training course. This will include covering the training related costs of job coaches, equipment, transportation and meals. BOB commits to spending all but 10% of the funds on training and will add additional courses if resources permit.
