TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

In accordance with Section 17 of the Noise Control By-law No. 6555, exception is hereby granted to MetroCan Construction Inc., 520-10470 152nd Street, Surrey, BC from May 25, 2008 to November 25, 2008 from 5:30 am to 7:30 am and from 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm on weekdays, and from 5:30 am to 10:00 am and from 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm on Saturdays (Sundays and holidays are excluded). This exemption is for the construction of the building structures and systems in the SEFC and Olympic Village Project - no pile driving or excavation and heavy trucking is allowed. Vehicle movements shall be arranged to minimize idling and the sounding of back-up warning devices. Crews are to eliminate all unnecessary noise.

It should be noted that this exception of the Noise Control By-law does not alter the applicant's responsibility to obtain whatever permits or approvals are required from other City Departments.

It is also understood that MetroCan Construction Inc. will notify all residential accommodations within one block radius concerning the work. MetroCan Construction Inc. agrees that every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum and this permit is subject to curtailment or cancellation if reasonable complaints are received.
