TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

In accordance with Section 17 of the Noise Control By-law No. 6555, exception is hereby granted to MetroCan Construction Inc., 520-10470 - 152nd Street, Surrey, BC from November 25, 2008 to October 31, 2009, from 5:30am to 7:30am and from 8:00pm to 10:00 pm on weekdays, and from 5:30am to 10:00am and from 8:00pm to 10:00pm on Saturdays (Sundays and Holidays are excluded). This exemption is for the construction of the building structures and systems in the SEFC and Olympic Village Project - no pile driving or excavation and heavy trucking is allowed. Vehicle movements should be arranged so as to minimize the sounding of back-up warning devices. Crews are to eliminate all unnecessary noise.

It should be noted that this exception of the Noise Control By-law does not alter the applicant's responsibility to obtain whatever permits or approvals are required from other City Departments.

It is also understood that MetroCan Construction Inc. will notify all residential accommodations within one block radius concerning the work. MetroCan Construction Inc. agrees that every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum and this permit is subject to curtailment or cancellation if reasonable complaints are received.
