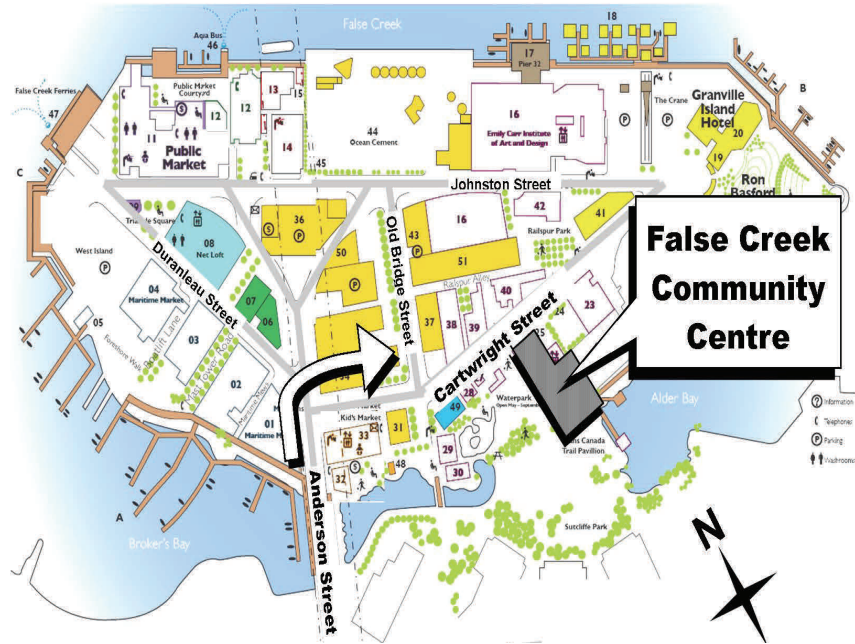


How To Find Us

Located on Granville Island, off West 4th Avenue. Turn north on to Anderson Street underneath the Granville Street Bridge. As you drive past the Kids Market stay in the right-hand lane. The False Creek Community Centre is on your right-hand side, just after the Waterpark and before Arts Umbrella, at 1318 Cartwright Street.

FAQ's:

Can I reserve Sutcliffe Park for a Wedding?

No, only designated Vancouver Park Board picnic sites can be "reserved". See www.vancouverparks.ca for all details. If you would like your wedding in the park, your group must be 50 people or less with no set up. Additional tents, rental chairs, alcohol, confetti, amplifiers are not allowed (one 10'x10' canopy for the couple only). Please be respectful of other park users.

What about taking wedding photos in Sutcliffe Park?

All park areas are first-come, first-served. Please be respectful of other park users when choosing an area for photos.

How do I book the Granville Island Picnic Pavilion?

The Picnic pavilion is not a Vancouver Park Board Picnic Pavilion. It is booked through the **Granville Island Cultural Society**. Reservations are free but required. Simply download the booking request form and send it by fax to 604-689-0006 or by email to giculturalsociety@telus.net. Who can rent a room?

Rooms at the Community Centre may be rented based on availability during designated hours. Center programs have priority and all rentals are subject to the approval of the False Creek Community Association. Before booking the space, we suggest that you to view the rooms and facilities. Virtual room 360° tour available at www.falsecreekcc.ca

How far in advance can I rent a room?

During Community Centre operating hours for meetings, you can book 2 or 3 months in advance. Community Centre programs are run seasonally, and get first priority for rooms. The halls may be rented after hours on Saturday or Sunday.

How do I rent and pay for a room?

Call 604-257-6998 or come in (Mon to Fri 9 am-4 pm) with the following information for the rental coordinator:

- 1) Type of event
- 2) Date and time of event
- 3) Number attending
- 4) Payment over the phone or in person
- 5) Completed rental agreement when applicable

Regular rates: All profit organizations or businesses and private functions.

Affiliated rates: All non profit organizations or groups affiliated to the Community Centre such as: False Creek Racing Canoe Club, Pacific Road Runners, and the False Creek Tennis Club. Your non-profit society name & number are required at time of booking.

G.S.T./H.S.T.

If you have GST exempt status, your GST registration number is required at the time of booking. All rental prices include H.S.T.

H.S.T. effective on all bookings after July 1, 2010.

Can I serve alcohol?

You must have the following to serve alcohol during your rental:

- 1) approval from the Rental Coordinator.
- 2) liquor permit and 'Serving It Right' certificate.

Alcohol is not permitted during the Centre's operating hours.
