Explanation for Fees changes

Due to the very high volume of customers and long lineups at the Ghost Train & Bright Nights, final prices are rounded to the nearest dollar. This practice is typical at tourist attractions and helps speed up customer service and limit the need for higher floats / more cash pickups.

Every attraction is different but the train and farmyard are competitive. The prime location in Stanley Park and the high volume of summer visitors ensures a constant flow of customers, many of whom are tourists. The overall net increase has been set slightly higher than the 4% expected increase in costs and will contribute towards decreasing the deficit at the Train & farmyard.

Train or Farmyard proposed regular rate per family member (most people pay this rate) for January 1, 2010 is \$3.25 and will increase at July 1, 2010 to \$3.50. This compares to the closest competition at Maplewood Farms (2009 rates of adult - \$5.25 & a child - \$3) and Bear Creek Train (2009 rates of adult - \$3.50 and child - \$2.50).

The Bright Nights proposed rates are \$9 for an adult and \$6 for the discounted rate. This is a unique venue but can be compared to the VanDusen Festival of Lights with proposed rates for an adult of \$13 and discounted rates of \$9.50 (senior) and \$7.25 (child).

Past practice has been to increase fees for either Bright Nights or both the Ghost Train and regular fees each year. In 2008 Bright Nights prices were increased. In 2009 Ghost Train & regular train & farmyard prices were increased. For 2010 we are proposing to increase prices for all events to reduce the deficit at these attractions, comply with the introduction of the HST by the province and avoid excessive increases at one event.

Explanation for Fees changes

Golf fees are set in response to market conditions, which include competitor's rates, condition of our courses and competitors courses, environmental conditions and economic conditions. Green fee pricing is flexible, giving our courses the ability to offer specials at certain times of the year and times of day in response to market conditions. Our proposed fee strategy for 2010 is based on market comparisons and projected impact of HST.

We are developing strong promotional plan to communicate the change to fees that will come with the introduction of the HST. We are also limiting senior rates at Fraserview and McCleery to Monday - Thursday only; Langara will continue to offer senior rates Monday to Friday, and all courses will continue to offer early morning and seasonal senior specials.

Rates at Fraserview are proposed to increase at a rate lower than inflation because there has been a decline in rounds. Recently Riverway Golf Course in Burnaby has installed slit drainage in all their fairways, which has had an impact on Fraserview's rounds.

Youth rates will be reduced as a way of encouraging young golfers and families to use our facilities. This will have a minimum impact on overall revenue, and is a good long term marketing strategy to "grow the game". The advanced booking fee for McCleery will be increased from \$5 to \$7.50, which places it in between Fraserview \$10 and Langara \$5.
