tips: Don't leave anything in your vehicle. • Be sure to watch the gate close each time you leave or enter secure parking areas. • Look for a well-lit, open area, near pedestrian activity if you're parking outside. • Keep an extra key with you, not in the vehicle. • Never assume your vehicle won't attract a thief. • Avoid the buildup of old insurance decals on your vehicle licence plates when applying new ones. • Lock your vehicle. • Invest in a good anti-theft device.

note: This list records the make and model of vehicles stolen in B.C. from January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012. All vehicles — whether they appear on this list or not — are at risk of theft. To help protect your vehicle, it's worth investing in the best anti-theft system you can afford. Electronic immobilizers are effective in preventing theft and can qualify vehicle owners for a discount on auto insurance. But no anti-theft device is foolproof.
