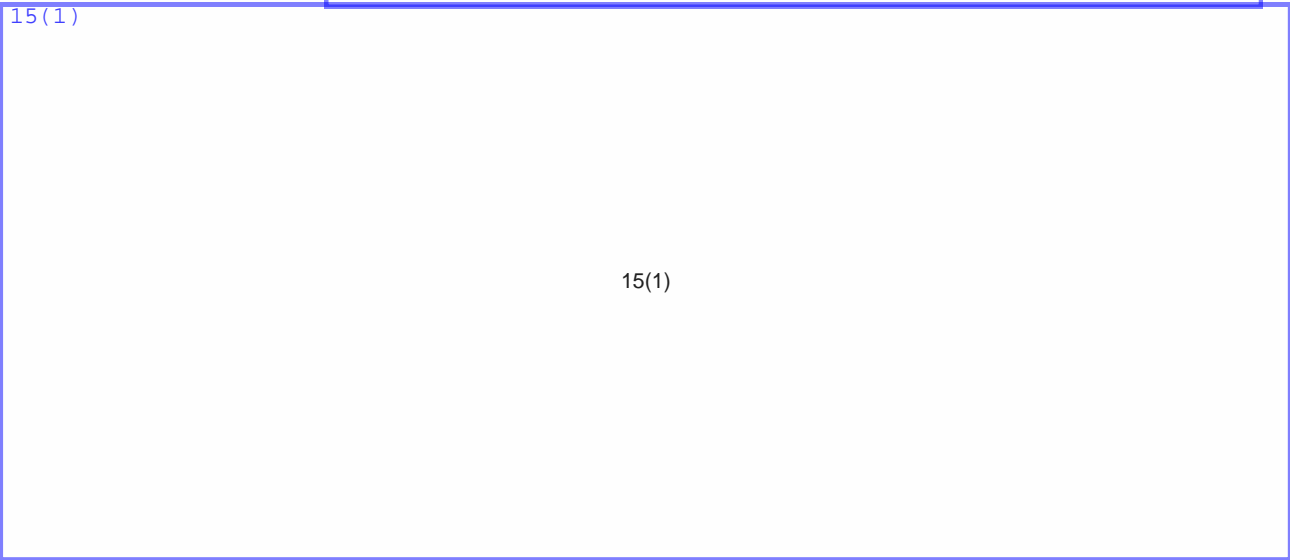

Subject: Disclosure of Residential Electricity Information **PR2006-074**


