The Vancouver Police Department is seeking applicants for casual fleet attendants to drive 10-15 passenger seat vans, shuttling police officers between venues and police buildings during the Celebration of Light fireworks. The position will include keeping routine clerical records and logbooks.

Applicants must be available to work 12- to 14-hour shifts, either day or nightshift, between July 28 to August 4, 2018.

REQUIREMENTS

- class 5 B.C. driver's license - class 4 is preferred
- thorough knowledge of the traffic rules and regulations governing the safe operation of passenger automobiles and vans
- clean driver's abstract
- ability to communicate verbally, effectively, and tactfully with peers and supervisors within the police department, with City of Vancouver staff, and with the general public
- ability to make independent decisions in a timely manner
- knowledge of the City of Vancouver buildings and street locations
- ability to follow oral and written instructions
- must obtain and maintain an enhanced security clearance.
- must provide a driver's abstract (available from the Motor Vehicle Branch) with application
