2. West End Lanes

Further to the last meeting held November 20, 2017, and the Regular Council meeting held November 28, 2017, staff provided further information regarding the lanes recommended as “Jepson-Young Lane” and “Jung Lane”. Staff also sought the Committee’s approval of proposed blade sign subtexts for the two lanes that include the individual’s full names. In discussion, the Committee expressed support.

The Committee agreed to separate the components of the following motion for the vote.

- A. THAT the Civic Asset Naming Committee recommend to Council that the existing lane located between Comox Street and Pendrell Street which runs from Thurlow Street to Cardero Street, and from Bidwell Street to Stanley Park, be named as “Jepson-Young Lane”.

- B. THAT the Civic Asset Naming Committee recommend to Council that the existing lane located between Harwood Street and Beach Avenue/Pacific Street which runs from Burrard Street to Cardero Street, be named as “Jung Lane”.

The Committee reviewed a list of proposed blade sign subtexts for West End Lanes, including “Jepson-Young Lane” and “Jung Lane”, and suggested edits for clarification. In addition, members agreed that punctuation can be at staff’s discretion.
