1. Civic Updates

Eric Fredricksen congratulated Sara MacLellan and Diyan Achjadi on being elected as Chair and Vice-Chair of the Public Art Committee, and provided updates on three public art projects previously presented to the Committee: a documentary film being made about Agents of Change, continuing installation work for Lead Pencil Studio's Home and Away in Hastings Park, and Douglas Coupland's Spawn at Vancouver Centre II.

2. Pinnacle International – 601 Beach Crescent (DPAP)

Peter Kreuk, Public Art Consultant, presented the detailed public art plan for Pinnacle International – 601 Beach Crescent, gave an overview of the public art selection process, and responded to questions and comments.

3. Bosa – 1065 & 1066 Harwood (DPAP)

Pablo Leppe, Director of Design at Bosa Properties, introduced the project. Ben Mills, Public Art Consultant, presented the updated detailed public art plan for the two new developments in the West End neighborhood, noting changes made in response to the Committee's recommendations when the DPAP was previously presented on December 12, 2022 and responded to comments and questions.
