1. Civic Updates

Staff provided updates on the following:

- Nine Places for Seeing, the first <u>Platforms program</u> dedicated exclusively to the work of Indigenous artists;
- Artist call for Arbutus Greenway Billboards;
- City of Reconciliation 10 Year Anniversary;
- Maintenance Aerodynamic Forms in Space; and
- Eleena Marley, new Managing Director of Arts and Culture.

2. Collection: Flow

Staff from Public Art presented to the Committee on Fiona Bowie and Sidney Fels's multimedia artwork *Flow*, which is being considered for deaccession from the City's public art collection, and responded to questions and comments.

Maureen Smith, Public Art Consultant, presented the preliminary public art master plan (PPAP) for the development located at 949 West 41st Avenue, and along with Mike Burak, Vice-President, Development, Grosvenor, responded to questions and comments.

FURTHER THAT the Public Art Committee recommend the following in developing the detailed public art plan:

- Include a more detailed history of the project site;
- Promote an integrated approach through the works on all phases, allowing dialogue between the artists through phases, encouraging artists to be aware of art and their processes (including participants) from earlier phases;
- In art on the first phase of the project, acknowledge future works in future phases;
- Consider crafting broader guidelines and principles to guide the works through phases;
- Openness to other materials and modalities of working;
- More First Nations involvement, including a member on the jury; and
- Ensure working artists participate in the selection panel.
