Committee Priorities

- Priority 1 Advise the City on measures it could take to encourage more active transportation and use of transit during the pandemic and how those measures could be used as pilots for permanent improvements.
- Priority 2 Improve and support the transportation-related elements of the Climate Emergency Response Plan.
- Priority 3 Secure approval for a redesign of the Granville Bridge that encourages the use of active transportation and transit on the bridge.

Top 3 2019/2020 Accomplishments

Granville Bridge improvements approved by council

Transportation elements of Climate Emergency Response Plan approved by council

Several measures taken to facilitate increased use of active transportation during the pandemic. Commitment to 11% of road space being converted to public use (e.g. plazas, gathering places, active transportation).

Top 3 Future Goals

Continue to advise the City on measures it could take to encourage more active transportation and use of transit during the pandemic and how those measures could be used as pilots for permanent improvements.

Provide advice on the implementation of the transportation elements of the Climate Emergency Response Plan, including measures to encourage transit use like bus priority lanes and safe infrastructure like improved crosswalks for pedestrians.

Ensure that the Broadway Plan includes a commitment to a complete street on Broadway and provide feedback to city staff on draft designs.
