Subject: Upcoming Britannia Renewal rezoning engagement launch

Dear Mayor and Council,

I am writing to inform you that the City will be issuing an information bulletin on March 10 regarding the launch of the latest phase of engagement for the Britannia Renewal. Here's some key information:

- Engagement will focus on developing site options that will inform the rezoning application for the site, and will be the first step in realizing goals defined in the Britannia Renewal Master Plan, which was co-created in 2018 by community members, the City and project partners (Vancouver Park Board, Vancouver School Board, Vancouver Public Library and Britannia Community Services Society).
- Engagement will take place online on the Shape Your City platform from March 9 to April 2, and activities include a virtual open house, Talk Van survey and a virtual showcase event.
- VPL Britannia branch are offering a loan-a-laptop service for community members without computer access, or the option to use their computers in branch. A paper survey option is available too.
- In addition to this public engagement stream, project partners are also facilitating focused engagement streams for Britannia community members – details over on the [Shape Your City Britannia Renewal project page](#).
