I am writing to inform you that the City will be issuing a news release on March 11, 2021, marking the one-year anniversary since COVID-19 was declared a pandemic.

- Fly flags at half-mast to honour lost lives on March 11 from dawn to dusk
- Light City Hall, Burrard Bridge, and Bloedel Conservatory blue and/or yellow, in support of healthcare and frontline workers, and as a symbol of hope
