Good morning,

Please see below for a summary of today's announcement from the Prime Minister:

4 April 2020 – PM Address

- Federal government will continue to work with provinces to have a complete national picture available to all Canadians
- Reiterating stay home / social distancing measures, but recognizing that some people do not have a safe, secure home to find refuge.
- \$200 M to help homeless shelters, domestic abuse victims
 - o \$40 M for shelters and centres for women (and children) facing domestic abuse and sexual violence
 - o \$10 M for shelters for emergency shelters for Indigenous women facing violence
 - o \$157 M for Reaching Home Program to support the homeless
- In the next 48 hours, Canada will be receiving a shipment of millions of masks
- Canada has leased a warehouse in China to coordinate and distribute masks and materials

- Of the \$157.5 million in Reaching Home funding, Canada's largest cities will receive allocations in the following amounts:
 - o Ottawa (\$7,213,954)
 - o Toronto (\$22,169,573)
 - o Hamilton (\$2,548,685)
 - o **Vancouver (\$13,522,453)**
 - o Winnipeg (\$2,936,322)
 - o Calgary (\$13,517,143)
 - o Edmonton (\$7,572,510)
 - o Halifax (\$1,557,674)
 - o St. John's (\$979,047)
 - o Moncton (\$669,162).
 - o In Quebec, this Reaching Home funding will be administered through a new Canada-Quebec Agreement that respects the jurisdiction and priorities of both governments.
