Further to Lon LaClaire's memo from March 18, I am writing to inform you that the City will be issuing a news release on April 12 announcing the launch of a School Streets Pilot, a partnership between the City and the Vancouver School Board.

A few key points include:

П	The School Street Pilot will last for four weeks at three elementary schools (Lord Roberts, Hastings and Van Horne). A school street is a car-free block beside a school open to walking, biking, and rolling during drop-off and pick-up.
	The goals of the pilot are to help improve safety, encourage active travel and reduce carbon pollution, which is part of the Climate Emergency Action Plan and Transportation 2040 Plan.
