Dear Mayor and Council,

Please find below the daily provincial update prepared by our IGR team –

**Number of COVID-19 Cases:**

- 27 new cases in the last 4 hours
- 1,517 total cases in British Columbia
  - o 658 VCH
  - o 601 FHA
  - o 89 VIH
  - o 141 IHA
  - o 28 NHA
  
- 942 recovered fully

**Misc. Additional Cases:**

- 3 additional cases reported in the nursery in the Interior. (Foreign temporary workers)
- 1 additional case in an Interior correctional facility

**Deaths:**

- 3 new deaths in last 24 hours (all in long term care facilities)
- 72 total deaths in BC

**Long Term Care Facilities:**

- 1 additional facility has reported a case: South Granville Park Lodge in VCH
- 20 other long term care facilities have ongoing, active cases
  - o 298 cases in long term care facilities
    - o 165 residents
    - o 174 staff

**Mission Correctional Centre:**

- 41+ cases, plus ongoing testing and pending cases
- 7 in hospital
- Mobile health unit will be redeployed from Vancouver Convention Centre to Abbotsford Hospital to provide support

**Number of Hospitalizations:**

- 134 in hospital in BC today
  - o 58 in ICU
  - o 37 hospitalizations in VCH

**Surgeries:**

- 13,938 surgeries have been cancelled in BC to date, but there continues to be emergency and some

scheduled surgeries happening

- 8,000+ surgeries (50% of which were scheduled) have taken place

- Both Dr. Henry and Minister Dix brought attention to the continuing overdose health emergency in the province.
