Subject: Upcoming IB: Resuming Kits and Point Grey Parking Enforcement

Dear Mayor and Council,

We are taking additional measures to support the City and Park Board's efforts to reduce the numbers of people congregating on beaches and trails. This Friday, as we did earlier in the West End, we are resuming enforcement of residential permit-parking zones in Kitsilano and Point Grey, which will make it harder for non-locals to find parking in these beach-front neighbourhoods. Parking enforcement officers will begin ticketing cars without appropriate permits that are parked in permit-parking zones in Kitsilano and Point Grey on Friday. Large signs will be placed at access points, so drivers are aware parking enforcement has resumed. We will be issuing an Information Bulletin to that effect Thursday morning.
