Subject: Upcoming IB: Completion of Beach Avenue interim upgrades (April 26, 2021)

Dear Mayor and Council,

I am writing to inform you that the City will be issuing a news release on April 26 announcing the completion of interim safety and design upgrades to Beach Avenue.

Should they be helpful to you, a few key messages include:

- Our interim improvements along Beach Avenue are now completed, designed to increase safety and public space for people who walk, cycle, take transit or drive.
- The new features include painted zebra crosswalks, tactile walking surfaces for the visually impaired, modified traffic signals and bus boarding islands, restored motor vehicle and transit access eastbound between Denman and Pacific streets and the replacement of traffic cones with sturdier and harder-to-move concrete barriers along the two-way protected bike path.
- The upgrades were based on feedback the City received in a survey last fall.
- The cost for the project was \$250,000.
