Good morning Mayor and Council,

Please see the PMs daily update for April 24, 2020. Great news for small and medium businesses!

- Virtual Vigil today for the victims of Nova Scotia shooting
- *New* Canada Emergency Commercial Rent Assistance: reached agreements with provinces & territories to lower commercial rent by 75% for small and medium businesses for April, May, and June
- Government will cover 50% of that reduction and the owner will pay the rest
 - It also available for small non-profits and charities
 - Monthly rent has to be below \$50K
 - The program will provide forgivable loans to qualifying commercial property owners to cover 50% of three monthly rent payments that are payable by eligible small business tenants experiencing financial hardship
 - The loans will be forgiven if the mortgaged property owner agrees to reduce the eligible small business tenants' rent by at least 75% for the three corresponding months under a rent forgiveness agreement (which will include a term not to evict the tenant while the agreement is in place)
 - o The small business tenant would cover the remainder, up to 25% of the rent.
- More news for larger corporations coming soon
- It is expected that this program will be operational by mid-May, with commercial property owners lowering the rents of their small business tenant's payable for April and May retroactively, and for June.
