Provincial Cabinet Update – 4/29/2020

- State of emergency extended for two more weeks
 - Mike Farnworth, Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General, has officially extended the state of emergency through the end of the day on May 12, 2020
- Economy coming back in phases in the near term, and the province will announce its reopening plan next week
- Phased in approach to reopening
- BC approach to economy and business restrictions has been different than other provinces, with many businesses allowed to stay open during the pandemic with guidelines for safe operations
 - Tree planting season will continue with safety guidelines
 - BC never shut down our construction sector, put in place guidelines for safe operations
- Request for business owners and associations to put together plans for safe operations
- Need to build consumer confidence with guidelines to protect workers and customers
- Don't anticipate regular return to education until into September
