Mayor and Council:

As you are likely aware, public engagement activities were paused in mid-March due to COVID 19. As part of our thinking around business continuity and efforts to support recovery, staff are exploring how our public engagement work might continue virtually (e.g. online, in writing or phone).

Using our Talk Vancouver survey platform, residents and community members are invited to share their thoughts on participating in engagement activities during COVID, preferences for how they would like to be involved, and ideas for making City engagement activities more inclusive.
