The micro-weddings pilot we told you about earlier will be open for venue registrations as of this Thursday, with the first weddings set to take place on Friday, June 19. We had earlier planned to launch a pilot for civil weddings this spring /summer with options to hold a ceremony in Council Chambers or outdoor on the plaza.
