Here is today's Provincial Health Office Update – May 7, 2020

Number of Cases:

- 33 new cases
 - o Total cases in BC: 2,288
- 865 VCH
- 1,064 FHR
- 126 VIH
- 179 IHA
- 54 NHA

- No new outbreaks in long term care facilities
 - o 21 ongoing

Community Outbreaks

- Poultry processing plants
 - o 56 at Superior Poultry
 - o 35 at United Poultry
 - o 7 at a poultry processing plant in the Fraser Valley
- Mission Correctional Facility
 - o 134 cases
- Kerl Lake, Alta Plant
 - o 16 cases

Hospitalizations

- 76 currently in hospital
 - o 20 in ICU
 - o 28 in VCH
- 3,948 beds available (64.6% capacity)

Deaths

- 2 additional deaths
 - o 1 in VCH
- 126 total deaths in BC

Recoveries

- 1,512 fully recovered

Comments

- BC's Restart Plan; we're in Phase 1 and need to continue safety measures to bend the curve down
- Continue to stay at home if you can and continue safe physical distancing
- Guidelines may not be as clear as people would like because everyone's circumstances are unique

- Province is working with WorkSafe BC to outline specific requirements for industries and sectors
 - Businesses will need to make decisions for themselves if they can meet requirements
- Template plans and checklists are being developed for organizations and businesses
- Minister Dix acknowledged overdose crisis and response being led by Minister Darcy
