Here is today's Provincial Health Office Update – May 12, 2020

Number of Cases:

- 7 new cases
 - o Total cases in BC: 2,360
- 874 VCH
- 1,124 FHR
- 125 VIH
- 180 IHA
- 57 NHA

- No new outbreaks in long term care facilities

- No new community outbreaks

Hospitalizations

- 63 currently in hospital
 - o 16 in ICU
- 3,760 beds available (66.3% capacity)

Deaths

- 1 additional deaths
- 131 total deaths in BC

Recoveries

- 1,832 fully recovered

Comments

- Launched province wide survey on peoples' experiences with COVID-19 to better understand the impact of the pandemic on people and inform future government decisions

- People who complete the survey will be asked if they want to participate in:
 - o serology survey (blood testing) to help determine immunity across the population
 - o survey on using technology and digital services to plan for future waves
- Transition into Phase 2 – Province is hearing from some people want to move forward faster and others who are fearful of moving too fast
- WorkSafe BC and public health organizations are working on guidance for businesses and the public
