Dear Mayor and Council,

Here is today's PM update for May 19, 2020:

- Feds expanding eligibility of CEBA (\$40K loan):
 - Sole owner-operator
 - Businesses that rely on contractors
 - Family-owned business that pay employees through dividends
 - Hair salons with stylists who rent chairs, gym owners with contracted trainers

- Canada and USA have agreed to extend the border closure to non-essential travel until June 21. This is an important decision that will keep people in both our countries safe, he says.

- PM says small biz minister Mary Ng is working on potential solutions for business owners without a business account, or new business that hasn't filed tax returns yet. No details on timeline yet.
