Greetings Mayor and Council,

Here is today's **Provincial Health Office Update – 5/21/2020**

Number of Cases:

- 12 new cases
 - o Total cases in BC: 2,479
- 887 VCH
- 1,223 FHR
- 126 VIH
- 183 IHA
- 60 NHA

- No new outbreaks in long term care facilities
 - o 17 ongoing
- 1 new community outbreak
 - o 1 case at Matsqui federal corrections institution
- United Poultry outbreak has now been declared over and plant is operating

Hospitalizations

- 43 currently in hospital
 - o 8 in ICU
 - o 19 in VCH
- Hospital beds are at 69% capacity

Deaths

- 3 additional deaths
- 152 total deaths in BC

Recoveries

- 2,020 people fully recovered

Comments

- 40,000 travellers entering BC have been screened
 - o 125 people provided with accommodation to self-isolate
- Cases and gender in BC:
 - o 52% of cases in women and 48% of cases in men
 - o 60% of those hospitalized are men and men account for 62% of deaths
 - o These stats are in keeping with international stats that show the health effects of COVID-19 are more severe for men
- Non-medical masks are recommended as an additional precaution in certain situations, including enclosed settings like transit and when getting personal services like haircuts

- Province is confident in approach for reopening schools in June and safety protocols that are in place
- 290,000 people have completed the BC COVID-19 survey
