Subject: Strathcona Park - update

Good morning Mayor and Council,

Over the course of the long weekend, our Engineering team continued their engagement with the individuals who are occupying street right-of-way on Raymur Avenue. Engineering has removed the majority of the material that had been left on the road following the decampment of the park. As of this morning, there were three individuals occupying an area on Raymur delineated by a 20'x20' tarpaulin. One of those individuals has accepted an offer of housing and the other two have been referred to Orange Hall and the CoV Outreach Office on Powell St for any assistance with housing.

There is another group of individuals who are attending the location in varying numbers to observe or advocate.

The individuals occupying the roadway have been clearly advised of the requirement to remove their belongings. Communication is continuing with a view to achieving voluntary compliance. At the point we determine those efforts to be unproductive, we will advise Council regarding our next steps.
