Dear Mayor and Council,

I am writing to inform you that the City will be issuing a news release tomorrow, May 28, to announce the opening of a new shelter at 875 Terminal Ave.

The shelter, operated by Lu'ma Native Housing Society and funded by BC Housing, will provide 60 safe spaces for people to sleep with access to meals, showers and laundry. This is the second new shelter to open in Vancouver this month and has a pod system for beds which provides shelter guests with more privacy and their own space, and meets COVID-19 guidance for distancing. The other new BC Housing-funded shelter located at 15-27 West Hastings Street opened on May 21 and is providing another 60 beds.
