**Subject:** Upcoming IB: Patio Permits

Dear Mayor and Council,

City of Vancouver has issued 15 temporary expedited patio permits since the program started on Monday to help businesses impacted by COVID-19.

These permits will allow restaurants and liquor serving establishments to take advantage of the improving weather and expand their indoor seating out onto public street, parking and sidewalk space in front or next to their business. As Paul outlined in his email yesterday, we were able to find a way to approve patios for breweries that are on the public right of way. That will also be announced today. Staff are also developing further recommendations for consideration by Council that will include bylaws changes to accommodate temporary patios for breweries on private property. The IB will be distributed today.
