Subject: Upcoming IB: Pop-up Plazas and Parklets

Dear Mayor and Council,

The City of Vancouver will be installing its first temporary plaza on Friday June 12, 2020 at 27th and Fraser as part of its ongoing COVID recovery efforts. The plaza will be the first in a number of new spaces City staff will be creating in the coming weeks to give people space to eat, visit, rest, and enjoy the weather while maintaining a safe distance from others. Staff will also be installing a number of new parklets in the Downtown East Side on Friday to support local residents as services reopen and additional space as needed.

Mayor and Council will be receiving a briefing memo from staff on these initiatives. We will be notifying the public about the temporary plaza and parklet program via our BIA partners, a media bulletin and via City social media channels.
