Dear Mayor and Council,

I have received confirmation that the graffiti was removed by our contractor.

For hate graffiti on public property, our contractor will remove the graffiti within 4 working hours of it being reported (our normal service level is 3-days). We do have a streamlined 3-1-1 script which flags this type of graffiti and the case gets sent directly to our contractor for servicing so if possible I would recommend reporting hate/racist graffiti through 3-1-1 which will get to our contractor quickly.

Also, our contractor, Goodbye Graffiti, will also remove hate/racist graffiti on private property for free as a company policy. So if you know victims of hate graffiti we can pass this message on too.
