**Subject:** Special Council Meeting for Tuesday, June 30 at 3 pm

Greetings Mayor and Council,

The Mayor has called a Special Council Meeting for Tuesday, June 30 at 3 pm. The purpose of the meeting is to convene a public hearing to consider amendments to the Zoning and Development By-law for Temporary Patios. This flows from Council debate and decision at our meeting of June 11 where Council requested to hold the public hearing earlier than the date originally proposed by staff as part of our COVID-19 response to support local business and community.

Given the intense schedule of Council, the earliest date to consider the proposed by-law amendment is June 30. With a meeting already scheduled for a Sign By-law reconsideration at 6 pm on June 30, the Special Council Meeting (for the purpose of a public hearing) will convene at 3 pm.

Staff complied with the statutory notification requirements for the public hearing in accordance with the Vancouver Charter. Under Part 14 of the Procedure By-law, the Mayor can call a Special Council Meeting. The Mayor also has the authority to modify the procedure at a public hearing as set out in section 13.14(d) of the Procedure By-law.
