Dear Mayor and Council,

I am writing to inform you that the City will be issuing an information bulletin on Tuesday, June 29 reminding property owners that the property tax payment due date is less than one week away.

Should they be helpful to you, some key messages we will be sharing in the bulletin include:

- Due date for payment of residential and non-residential property taxes is July 5, 2021 at midnight
- Online payment is encouraged and is the quickest and easiest method
- Other payment methods include:
 - via bank/ATM
 - cheque drop off at City Hall mail slot
 - in-person at City Hall (during business hours, no cash, COVID-19 measures in place)
- Home owner grant applications and Tax Deferment Program applications are to be submitted directly to the province, not the City
