I am writing to inform you that the City will be issuing a news release jointly with the Vancouver Park Board on Wednesday, June 30, regarding the opening of Glen Pump Station in China Creek North Park.

Should they be helpful to you, here are some key facts we will be sharing in the news release:

- Now open in China Creek North Park, Glen Pump Station has increased capacity to help serve the growing neighbourhood of Mount Pleasant and was built as part of the City's capital renewal program.
- Thanks to this Engineering project, China Creek North Park has new amenities including two accessible washrooms, a water fountain and public art featuring Vancouver's buried streams and Vancouver Community College's velodrome.
- The latest improvements follow enhancements made to China Creek North Park by the Park Board in 2019.
