## Note:

- (1) As the Host Local Government, the City receives a share of gaming revenue from the Parq/Edgewater and Hastings Racecourse casinos.
  - Gaming revenue is general revenue used to fund City police, fire, parks, engineering, community and other services.
- (2) Casinos contribute funds annually to the City to be used for social responsibility activities.
- (3) Social responsibility contributions are used to provide grants to community organizations with activities consistent with the social responsibility mandate.
- (4) The City leases the grounds and buildings to the operators of the Hastings Racecourse.
- (5) Lease proceeds are used to fund Hastings Park improvements.
