Subject: Upcoming IB: Update on Temporary Patio Permits

Dear Mayor and Council,

In the month since the City launched the Temporary Expedited Patio Program, over 180 temporary patio permits have been issued. As a result of zoning bylaw changes at a public hearing earlier this week, breweries, wineries and distilleries can now apply online for a temporary patio on private property. As part of the City's efforts to help residents safely return to community life as businesses continue to reopen, the City has installed a sixth pop-up plaza in Gastown.
