Mayor and Councillors,

During the July 20 Limited Service Food Establishment staff/council briefing, Councillor Carr asked whether the province is asking additional questions during the process of applying for a Special Event Permit.

Staff investigated and confirmed that there are no additional questions or information requested as part of the online application process. However, on the Special Event Permit homepage, there is a disclaimer confirming that the LCRB will be accepting applications for Special Event Permits for events of any size; however, all mass gatherings and events remain subject to any PHO orders, including any restrictions on size.
