Rena has accomplished many things as leader of the Civic Engagement and Communications (CEC) department over the past seven years. She has been a visionary leader by identifying and planning ahead to respond to changing trends in how the public, employees and the news media consume information. She has been a champion for engagement, including the recent launch of our new online platform Shape Your City.
