Subject: Special weather statement - increasing temperatures

Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

A Special Weather Statement has now been issued by Environment Canada regarding increasing temperatures on Wednesday through Saturday of this week. Thursday and Friday are expected to be the warmest days with cooler temperatures forecast for Sunday.

VEMA staff participated in a coordination call earlier today with Emergency Management BC, Environment Canada and VCH and we are preparing to activate our heat response plan. VCH confirmed that no additional protocols for COVID are needed for Cooling Centres since the risk of heat is higher than risk of COVID for the region.

VEMA will continue to monitor the situation and we will provide further updates as new information becomes available.
