Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

I am writing to update you on recent meeting with representatives of Marine Drive Golf Club. The Club reached out with a meeting request following the recent media attention to the restriction on public access their property along the southern boundary adjacent to the Fraser River.

Along with Lon and a number of his senior staff, we met with the Club president and COO. The Club representatives confirmed their interest to engage constructively with the City and other stakeholders in exploring the concept of a Fraser River trail connection through the course, along with possible options to achieve that objective. They also outlined several considerations for the Club, including implications for the course design and functionality, along with safety concerns.

Lon's team confirmed that Engineering staff worked on this issue several years ago and we have committed to review that work and share details with the Club. The Club also committed to review their files and share any relevant information.

We will keep you apprised of any developments as this joint work proceeds.
