Mayor and Council,

To confirm, VEMA (Vancouver Emergency Management Agency) is closely monitoring the air quality situation as it evolves over the weekend. VEMA is working with several partners, including Vancouver Coastal Health. As of 1pm on Friday Vancouver Coastal Health has advised to not open clean air centres. Teams are on standby over the weekend and will follow direction from public health.
