Subject: Update on E-scooter Pilot

Dear Mayor and Council,

At a recent meeting Council asked about the status of a e-scooter pilot.

As part of their stakeholder consultations which took place over August, staff have met with and provided the Province with input that reflects Council's direction from the July 7th Council Meeting as per the Transportation Safety Report in the following link: <https://council.vancouver.ca/20200707/documents/r2.pdf>

Staff are now waiting to hear back from the Province following input from all jurisdictions that are interested in a micromobility trial. Once we have more details on the changes to the MVA, staff will bring forward a report detailing the changes and also amendments to the Street and Traffic by-law to initiate a trial in the City. We expect more information to come forward this Fall and plan to have a report to Council later this year. The goal is to launch a trial of privately-owned micromobility devices early in 2021.
