Dear Mayor and Council,

Please see the attached memo from Gil Kelley and Lon LaClaire. A short summary of the memo is as follows:

- TransLink's Mayors' Council 10-Year Vision approved in 2014 called for all major capital projects to have a Supportive Policies Agreement (SPA) that identifies actions by the municipality and TransLink beyond the direct scope of the project that will contribute towards its success.
- In 2018, the City of Vancouver and TransLink executed the Broadway Subway Project SPA which also

outlines the process of monitoring and reporting on the SPA progress.

- The first Annual Report will be presented to the TransLink Board and Mayors Council within the next two weeks and provides an update on SPA initiatives as well as establishes baseline date for future monitoring.
