These 125 new homes were developed through the City's inclusionary zoning policy which provides social housing to the City as a Community Amenity Contribution (CAC) from the developer. YWCA, with the Association of Neighbourhood Houses of British Columbia (ANHBC) and Tikva Housing Society are managing the building. YWCA will be leading the tour. Other tours will also be hosted on the day and a news release will be issued to media celebrating the opening of the building.

Location: 4105 Arbutus Street (meet outside building). Please note tenants have started moving into the building, so please be mindful of privacy.

As per Provincial orders, masks will be required to tour the building.
