The purpose of this memo is to notify Council of upcoming engagement events for the Jericho Lands planning program.

Throughout the spring and summer 2021, the landowners' design team have collaborated with City staff to develop two conceptual site plans for the Jericho Lands. These site concepts illustrate how of ʔəy 'alməxw / y 'álməxw / Jericho Lands could look in the future. The concepts are based on the Emerging Ideas endorsed by Council in June 2021.

There are a number of engagement opportunities planned in the coming month including a Kick-off Event, Talk to a Team member pop-up office hours and an online survey.

The local community was notified of these events in the attached [Community Newsletter](#) which was distributed to approximately 12,000 households and businesses. The xʷməθkʷəy̓əm (Musqueam), Sḵwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and sə́lilwətaʔt (Tseil-Waututh) Nations members have also been invited through outreach coordinated by the joint venture partnership between the MST Partners and Canada Lands Company.

The staff team would like to invite Council to attend the Kick-off Event to learn more about the two conceptual site plans. If you are not able to attend on Monday, the presentation will be recorded and posted online.

Phase 3 Kick-Off Event: Conceptual Site Plan Options Presentation

On Monday, October 18, we will be co-hosting the Phase 3 Kick-Off event. This online event will feature a welcome from the xʷməθkʷəy̓əm (Musqueam), Sḵwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and sə́lilwətaʔt (Tseil-Waututh) Cultural Liaisons, a planning process overview, and presentations of the Conceptual Site Plan Options followed by a Q&A session. The event will be an opportunity to learn about the planning process and Conceptual Site Plan Options, as well as ask the team questions about the site options.

Where: Online using Zoom. A link to access the Kick-Off event will be sent to registered participants prior to the event.
